**Nordic Seaco** is proud to present new cooperation agreement with just another seine vessel **Sea Hunter**, from **Fosnavaag, Norway**. **Sea Hunter** will have close link to **Nordic Seaco**. The two other **Norwegian** purse seiners, the newbuilding **Bernt Oskar**, from Lofoten and refurbished **Harhaug 1**, from Ålesund. Recently also **Sea Hunter** was totally upgraded, so vessel to be classed as **#1 class** seine. **Sea Hunter** is fully equipped for freezing of catch, immediate onboard. This kind of preserving give best quality of fish, as **Cod, Haddock & Saithe**, species with highly demanded **MSC-certify**. **Nordic Seaco** itself, was re-approved as **MSC certified** exporter beginning of 2012. Certifying body, **Intertek Moody Marine**, approved Chain of Custody Certificate to be valid until **8th of January 2015**.

Together with **Sea Hunter**, **Nordic Seaco**, coordinated quality instructions for crew and owners mid January 2012. Well known fishing master, **Mr. Otto Giskeødegård**, was giving instructions at the local **College of Ålesund**, in state-of-the-art wet-lab facilities. **Sea Hunter** soon off for Cod catching in high seas in **FAO catching area 027**.
